CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

COOS COUNTY FOR BELLONI BOYS RANCH
COOS COUNTY COURTHOUSE
COQUILLE, OREGON 97423

confirms the right to use the waters of DAVIS CREEK, a tributary of DAVIS SLOUGH, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE AT BELLONI BOYS RANCH AND IRRIGATING 0.1 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45166. The date of priority is JUNE 4, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.005 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 26 S, R 13 W, W.M.; 1080 FEET NORTH AND 610 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.1 ACRE AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
