CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. FRANK SCHMIDT 9500 S.E. 327TH AVENUE BORING, OREGON 97009

confirms the right to use the waters of DOANE CREEK AND HOOD ACRES RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6645, a tributary of DEEP CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 21.9 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41974. The date of priority is MAY 11, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.27 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 1 S, R 4 E, W.M.; CREEK-1170 FEET SOUTH & 3420 FEET WEST; RESERVOIR - 1220 FEET SOUTH & 3850 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM NE CORNER SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-6645.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 21.9 ACRES SECTION 33 TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
