CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8311, a tributary of PALMER CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46105. The date of priority is AUGUST 21, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 6, T 6 S, R 3 W, W.M.; STREAM - 1000 FEET NORTH AND 2500 FEET WEST, RESERVOIR - 1320 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET WEST BOTH FROM SW CORNER DLC 59.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 2 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) 2.0 ACRES
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
