confirms the right to use the waters of THE UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of THE COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 58.4 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 40118. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 12, 1975. The right is limited to not more than 0.97 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 6, T 2 N, R 30 E, W.M. DIVERSION 2-950 FEET SOUTH AND 1660 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 6; NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 2 N, R 29 E, W.M.; DIVERSION 1-70 FEET SOUTH AND 650 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
