CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLAMINA CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 25.8 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41076. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 10, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40, SECTION 36, T 5 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 600 FEET NORTH AND 1440 FEET WEST; 1540 FEET NORTH AND 1630 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM SE CORNER DLC 40.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.9 ACRE
NE 1/4 NW 1/4 4.3 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.2 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4 9.5 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40
LOT 4 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4) 8.9 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
