CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 95.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-9531. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 22, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 1.18 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

LOT 4 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 1, T 15 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 1700 FEET NORTH AND 140 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) 22.6 ACRES LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) 7.8 ACRES SECTION 2 TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.
