CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

M. S. BOND
BAKER, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 108.7 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 291. The date of priority is 1899.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 ACRES
SECTION 21

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.1 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 6.6 ACRES
SECTION 28

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 4005, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 13, 1989.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
