CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of LONG TOM RIVER AND FERN RIDGE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625, tributaries of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for the purpose of PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 325.4 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 61.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45344. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 12, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 4.07 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FROM LONG TOM RIVER AND 132 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER FROM FERN RIDGE RESERVOIR or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

RIVER- SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 13 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 2330 FEET SOUTH AND 1210 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 25, FERN RIDGE- NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 17 S, R 5 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. The right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same lands and shall not exceed the limitations allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contracts 14-06-100-7802 and 7-07-10-W0067, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department. The right is further limited to the use of stored water only on the lands described as supplemental.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
