CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That J. L. CAVINESS
 of Island City, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Grande Ronde River
 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from June 1865

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per
 acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth
 of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Twenty-three (23) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter
 ($SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$), Thirty-two (32) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast
 Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$), Section Thirty-three (33); Township 2 South, Range 38 East
 of the Willamette Meridian; Forty (40) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the
 Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$), Twenty (20) acres in the Northwest Quarter of
 the Northeast Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$), Section Four (4), Twenty-seven (27) acres in
 the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$), Forty (40) acres
 in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$), Forty (40) acres
 in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$), Forty (40) acres
 in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$), Section Three
 (3), Township 3 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, being a
 total of 262 acres.

(NOTE: Is also tabulated under May Park Water Ditch which should be regarded
 as supplemental to this right.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations con-
 tained in said decrees.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
