confirms the right to use the waters of TENMILE LAKE, a tributary of TENMILE CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE EACH.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47039. The date of priority is JULY 30, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 18, T 23 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 1850 FEET SOUTH AND 330 FEET WEST FROM C 1/4 CORNER SECTION 18.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
