CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PERRY STEELE  
FIELDS, OREGON 97710

confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, a tributary of ALVORD LAKE, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 231 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 1440. The date of priority is JANUARY 2, 1913. The right is limited to not more than 2.89 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION; NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 39 S, R 36 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 33, T 38 S, R 35 E, W.M.; 360 FEET NORTH AND 40 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved and also describes that portion of the water right not modified by an order of the Water Resources Director entered september 17, 1946, and supersedes certificate 1422, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
