THE USE OF WATER UNDER THIS RIGHT IS SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AN ORDER ENTERED APRIL 2, 1976, PERTAINING TO ORDNANCE GRAVELS CRITICAL GROUND WATER AREA.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
