CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND UNNAMED RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-9972, a tributary of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of RECREATIONAL USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48757. The date of priority is AUGUST 2, 1984. The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40, SECTION 15,  
T 26 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1850 FEET NORTH AND 550 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER  
SECTION 15.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40  
SECTION 15  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
