confirms the right to use the waters of PATAWA CREEK, a tributary of UMATILLA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.8 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45086. The date of priority is APRIL 28, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 14, T 2 N, R 32 E, W.M.; 560 FEET NORTH AND 330 FEET WEST, 560 FEET NORTH AND 290 FEET WEST, 600 FEET NORTH AND 200 FEET WEST, 630 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET WEST, ALL FROM C1/4 CORNER SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.8 ACRES SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
