CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARKUS LACKNER  
941 FOOTS CREEK ROAD  
GOLD HILL, OREGON 97525

confirms the right to use the waters of GOLD GULCH CREEK, a tributary of FOOTS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45531. The date of priority is OCTOBER 29, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 35, T 36 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 10 FEET NORTH AND 90 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER SECTION 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4      4.0 ACRES  
SECTION 35  
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
