confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45600. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 3, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 1.0 GALLON PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 36 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 500 FEET NORTH AND 2470 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER SECTION 4.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
