CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of CAMP CREEK, a tributary of IMNAHA RIVER, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47245. The date of priority is OCTOBER 8, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 19, T 1 N, R 48 E, W.M.; 1600 FEET SOUTH AND 430 FEET WEST FROM N 1/4 CORNER SECTION 19.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
SE 1/4 NW 1/4  
NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
SECTION 20  
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 48 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
