CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47521. The date of priority is JANUARY 21, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39, SECTION 32, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 1340 FEET NORTH AND 1220 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 32.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
