CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MONROE ACRES

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM (AKA ECHO FALLS), a tributary of SILETZ RIVER, for the purposes of COMMERCIAL USE AT A TRAILER PARK (PUBLIC RESTROOMS AND NOT TO EXCEED 36 TRAILERS) AND DOMESTIC USE FOR 19 FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND GARDEN FOR EACH FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46802. The date of priority is OCTOBER 9, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.02 CFS FOR COMMERCIAL USE AND 0.06 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 8, T 8 S, R 10 W, W.M.; 1278 FEET NORTH 50 DEGREES 10 MINUTES WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 17.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) DOMESTIC  
LOT 5 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) DOMESTIC AND COMMERCIAL  
SECTION 8  
LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) DOMESTIC  
SECTION 17  
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 10 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
