CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of TEAL CREEK, a tributary of LITTLE LUCKIMUTE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 26.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48283. The date of priority is OCTOBER 14, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.33 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 8 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1750 FEET SOUTH AND 420 FEET WEST, 1150 FEET SOUTH AND 1130 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4	7.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4	11.4 ACRES
SW 1/4 NW 1/4	0.3 ACRE
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	7.5 ACRES

SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
