CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROSE B. LOVE, CLARENCE E. LOVE, FLOYD E. LOVE and
CHARLES H. COLTON
KEATING, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK OF LOVE CREEK AND LOVE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-610, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, for the purpose of THE SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 786.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 1510. The date of priority is OCTOBER 21, 1912. The right is limited to not more than 10.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 23, T 9 S, R 43 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
