confirms the right to use the waters of DESOLATION CREEK, a tributary of the NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, in the JOHN DAY BASIN to maintain instream flows for the purpose of ANADROMOUS AND RESIDENT FISH HABITAT.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN DESOLATION CREEK AND ITS TRIBUTARIES FROM THE CONFLUENCE OF THE FORKS AT RIVER MILE 21.5 (NW 1/4, SECTION 1, T 9 S, R 33 E, W.M.) TO THE MOUTH OF DESOLATION CREEK AT RIVER MILE 0 (SW 1/4, SECTION 36, T 6 S, R 31 E, W.M.).


The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.332 to 537.360.

The date of priority is DECEMBER 22, 1988.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
