confirms the right to use the waters of BUTTE CREEK, a tributary of the PUDDING RIVER, in the WILLAMETTE BASIN to maintain instream flows for the purpose of ANADROMOUS AND RESIDENT FISH HABITAT.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN BUTTE CREEK AND ITS TRIBUTARIES FROM THE SCOTTS MILLS-MAPLE GROVE BRIDGE AT RIVER MILE 15 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 15, T 6 S, R 1 E, W.M.) TO THE MOUTH OF BUTTE CREEK AT RIVER MILE 0 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 2, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.).


The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.332 to 537.360.

The date of priority is DECEMBER 22, 1988.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
