confirms the right to use the waters of ALTHOUSE CREEK, a tributary of the EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, in the ROGUE BASIN to maintain instream flows for the purpose of ANADROMOUS AND RESIDENT FISH HABITAT.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN ALTHOUSE CREEK AND ITS TRIBUTARIES FROM THE CONFLUENCE OF TARTER GULCH AT RIVER MILE 7.4 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 40 S, R 7 W, W.M.) TO THE MOUTH OF ALTHOUSE CREEK AT RIVER MILE 0 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.).


The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.332 to 537.360.
