CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LEONARD JOSEPH SAUNDERS 13400 KIRKWOOD ROAD SALEM, OREGON 97304

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING AND UNNAMED RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7691, a tributary of PALMER CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.3 ACRES AND FISH CULTURE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 43387. The date of priority is JULY 10, 1978. The right is limited to not more than 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.02 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.01 CFS FOR FISH CULTURE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 6 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 730 FEET SOUTH AND 2200 FEET WEST FROM NW CORNER DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre from direct flow, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.3 ACRES AND FISH CULTURE SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
