CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HARRY G. SPENCER P.O. BOX 291 LANGLOIS, OREGON 97450

confirms the right to use the waters of SPENCER CREEK AND SPENCER RESERVOIR 2 CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-10479, a tributary of CONNER CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 8.0 ACRES AND TEMPERATURE CONTROL OF 8.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49345. The date of priority is JANUARY 31, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.10 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.20 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 30 S, R 15 W, W.M.; 500 FEET SOUTH AND 3150 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 8.0 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
