CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CALVIN CHRISTENSEN
FAIRVIEW ROUTE, BOX 4187
COQUILLE, OREGON 97423

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER (SLOUGH) AND A SPRING, a tributary of COQUILLE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 3.1 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 39500. The date of priority is JUNE 10, 1975. The right is limited to not more than 0.045 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.04 CFS FROM THE RIVER FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FROM THE SPRING FOR DOMESTIC, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversions are located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 26 S, R 11 W, W.M.; RIVER - 750 FEET NORTH 1220 FEET WEST, SPRING - 680 FEET NORTH AND 1070 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.1 ACRE
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
