CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD HARLEN LUCAS SR.

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of HAYNES INLET, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.4 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45162. The date of priority is MAY 19, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.01 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 24 S, R 13 W, W.M.; 580 FEET NORTH AND 460 FEET EAST, 420 FEET NORTH AND 430 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM SW CORNER SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.4 ACRE AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
