CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of STOCK WATER AND BARN CLEANING.

The right has been perfected under Permit 15748. The date of priority is APRIL 10, 1944. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 58, SECTION 31,
T 1 S, R 4 W, W.M.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 58
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 15165, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on AUGUST 9, 1988.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
