CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE W. SMITH
HC-52 BOX 206
COOS BAY, OREGON 97420

confirms the right to use the waters of SMITH CREEK, a tributary of COOS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 15.3 ACRES AND FOR STOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 42170. The date of priority is AUGUST 9, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.195 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.19 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 25 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 520 FEET SOUTH AND 860 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 15.3 ACRES AND STOCK
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
