CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8257, a tributary of WEST FORK DAIRY CREEK, for the purpose of STOCK WATER AND RECREATION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45700. The date of priority is AUGUST 28, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK AND 0.01 CFS FOR RECREATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 2 N, R 4 W, W.M.; 1650 FEET SOUTH AND 1500 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 9  
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

NO APPROPRIATION OF WATER SHALL BE MADE FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM DURING THE PERIOD JULY 31 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 15 EXCEPT FOR LIVESTOCK CONSUMPTION.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
