CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A ROAD DITCH, a tributary of SNYDER CREEK, for the purpose of MAINTAINING SEWAGE LAGOON WATER CONDITION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49884. The date of priority is AUGUST 26, 1986. The right is limited to not more than 40.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 35 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 670 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4  
SECTION 28  
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
