of Prineville State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Newsom Creek, a tributary of Crooked River,

for the purpose of "the irrigation of 27.8 acres of land, and stock and domestic use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1877,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose Saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 35/100 cubic foot per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

3 acres in the NE1 of SW2; 9.8 acres in the SE2 of SW2; 15 acres in the NW2 of SE3; Section Eighteen (18) Township Seventeen (17) South Range Nineteen (19) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.
