confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM  
a tributary of DEAD INDIAN CREEK, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir  
permit R-4144. The date of priority is DECEMBER 22, 1960.

The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right  
is not more than 0.1 ACRE-FOOT.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 23  
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and  
maintenance of an outlet pipe or the provision of other means to  
evacuate the stored water when determined necessary by the Water  
Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted  
to beneficial use at the place of use described.
