confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK BEECH CREEK, a tributary of the BEECH CREEK, in the JOHN DAY BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of ANADROMOUS AND RESIDENT FISH HABITAT AND RECREATIONAL FISHING.

The right is for flows to be maintained in EAST FORK BEECH CREEK FROM THE MOUTH OF LAKE CREEK AT RIVER MILE 8.0 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 12 S, R 31 E, W.M.); TO THE MOUTH OF McCLELLAN CREEK AT RIVER MILE 4.0 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 22, T 12 S, R 31 E, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is JUNE 12, 1989.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below for an anadromous and resident fish habitat:
