confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK BEECH CREEK, a tributary of the BEECH CREEK, in the JOHN DAY BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of ANADROMOUS AND RESIDENT FISH HABITAT AND RECREATIONAL FISHING.

The right is for flows to be maintained in EAST FORK BEECH CREEK FROM THE MOUTH OF McCLELLAN CREEK AT RIVER MILE 4.0, (SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 22, T 12 S, R 31 E, W.M.); TO THE MOUTH OF BEECH CREEK AT RIVER MILE 0.0, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 18, T 12 S, R 31 E, W.M.).


The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.
