confirms the right to use the waters of LONG CREEK, a tributary of the MIDDLE FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, in the JOHN DAY BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of ANADROMOUS AND RESIDENT FISH HABITAT AND RECREATIONAL FISHING.

The right is for flows to be maintained in LONG CREEK FROM THE MOUTH OF THE SOUTH FORK LONG CREEK AT RIVER MILE 25.6, (SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 10 S, R 31 E, W.M.); TO THE MOUTH OF LONG CREEK AT RIVER MILE 0.0 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 9, T 8 S, R 29 E, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is JUNE 12, 1989.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
