CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7829, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER, for the purpose of ENHANCEMENT OF FISH LIFE BY IMPROVEMENT OF DOWNSTREAM ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44165. The date of priority is MAY 7, 1962, FOR 120 CFS, AND MAY 24, 1979, FOR 240 CFS. The right is limited to THE AMOUNTS DURING THE TIME PERIODS LISTED BELOW, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 36, T. 40 S., R. 4 W., W.M.; 1350 FEET SOUTH AND 2200 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 36 (APPLGATE DAM).

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

QUANTITIES (IN CUBIC FEET PER SECOND) OF STORAGE RELEASES WITH NATURAL FLOWS TO PROVIDE MINIMUM FLOWS IN THE DESCRIBED SECTION OF THE APPLGATE RIVER CHANNEL AS FOLLOWS:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use in the Applegate River Channel as described above.
