CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN E. AND MAXINE E. DEYOUNG
1095 THOMPSON CREEK ROAD
APPLEGATE, OREGON 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of THOMPSON CREEK, a tributary of APPLEGATE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.8 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46204. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 7, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 38 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 750 FEET SOUTH AND 1420 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.8 ACRE
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
