CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SNAKE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of FISH LADDER OPERATION AND ATTRACTION FOR TRAPPING.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46410. The date of priority is AUGUST 13, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 130.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 6, SECTION 4, T 4 S, R 49 E, W.M.; 5,494.5 FEET NORTH AND 19,840.2 FEET EAST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 6
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 49 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
