confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of WILLOW CREEK, in TWO RESERVOIRS (JENNE LAKES), appropriated under Permit 49676, for the purpose of RECREATION.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10625. The date of priority is MAY 23, 1986. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 8.1 ACRE FEET BEING 4.5 AF IN THE LOWER RESERVOIR AND 3.6 AF IN THE UPPER RESERVOIR.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
