CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND TWO RESERVOIRS CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-10625, a tributary of WILLOW CREEK, for the purpose of RECREATION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49676. The date of priority is MAY 23, 1986. The right is limited to not more than 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 32, T 1 N, R 1 W, W.M.; LOWER DAM - 2987 FEET SOUTH AND 20 FEET EAST, UPPER DAM - 2823 FEET SOUTH AND 485 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF DLC 43.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITH DLC 43
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
