CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SKIPANON RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of AQUACULTURE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49936. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1986. The right is limited to not more than 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 28, T 8 N, R 10 W, W.M.; 450 FEET NORTH AND 1240 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
NW 1/4 SE 1/4
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 8 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
