CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of ELGAROSE CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 8.7 ACRES, DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY, AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46095. The date of priority is JUNE 17, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR IRRIGATION, 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 26, T 26 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 2340 FEET NORTH AND 500 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4            8.7 ACRES, LIVESTOCK  
SECTION 26            AND DOMESTIC USE  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
