confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPELEGATE RIVER, a tributary of the APPELEGATE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 8.1 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1886 FOR 0.103 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND 1902 FOR 0.102 CFS.

The right is limited to not more than 0.205 CFS IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 24, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 450 FEET SOUTH AND 1500 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 24.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 26, 1979, and together with certificate 48963, supersedes certificate 37369, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
