CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DON E. MAKINSON
STAR ROUTE
HALFWAY, OREGON 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND A SPRING, both tributaries of PINE CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.8 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46001. The date of priority is JUNE 24, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.005 CFS FROM THE SPRING FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.02 CFS FROM THE STREAM FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 7 S, R 48 E, W.M.; STREAM-1920 FEET NORTH AND 1830 FEET EAST, SPRING - 2200 FEET NORTH AND 2360 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.8 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 48 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
