CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NORTON L. SMITH 3030 UPPER APPLEGATE ROAD JACKSONVILLE, OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLEGATE LAKE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, a tributary of APPLEGATE RIVER, for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 16.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48063. The date of priority is JUNE 2, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 10.0 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 2700 FEET SOUTH AND 640 FEET WEST FROM THE WEST SOUTHWEST CORNER OF DLC 37. APPLEGATE DAM - S 1/2 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract Number 3-07-10-W0505, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.7 ACRE NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.1 ACRE SECTION 9

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 8.0 ACRES NW 1/4 SW 1/4 7.2 ACRES SECTION 10

TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
