## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LEONARD ORCHARDS COMPANY GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 171.63 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 1155. The date of priority is APRIL 12, 1912. The right is limited to not more than 2.142 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 21, T 36 S, R 6 W, W.M.; NORTH 25 DEGREES EAST, 2020 FEET FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
