CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROUGH AND READY TIMBER COMPANY P.O. BOX 519 CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of the WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 8.6 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at page 70. The date of priority is 1905.

The right is limited to not more than 0.172 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 880 FEET NORTH AND 70 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.8 ACRE SW 1/4 NW 1/4 7.8 ACRES SECTION 28 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 10, 1983 and supersedes certificate 13876, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
