confirms the right to use the waters of JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 9.5 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1872.

The right is limited to not more than 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 35 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1260 FEET SOUTH AND 260 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 4.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 9.5 ACRES  
SECTION 4  
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 19, 1981, and together with certificate 50160, supersedes certificate 39368, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
